

EQUITABLE SHARING RATE 2025-2026

Effective for donations received between April 1, 2025 and March 31, 2026

What criteria are applied to determine the sharing rates?

Criterion 1 (50%): Percentage of total services provided

Criterion 2 (15%): Percentage of the total kilos of food distributed per person assisted

Criterion 3 (35%): Percentage of total households that are food insecure

Why these criteria:

Following a study conducted by a student at HEC, these criteria emerged as the most relevant and equitable. They reflect the current reality of food assistance provided by our members (criteria 1 and 2), while also taking into account the work still required to reach all individuals experiencing food insecurity in each territory (criterion 3).

When were the calculation criteria last updated?

The criteria are reviewed every 3 years and will be updated in 2026. They are unanimously approved by our members and ratified by the Board of Directors. The sharing rates themselves are updated annually.
