26,081 households supported 20.6% of respondents

Single-parent households



26,636 households supported 20.9% of respondents

Households primarily relying on social assistance



51.351 households supported 40.6% of respondents

Newcomers and refugees (in Canada for under 10 years)



53,761 people supported 34.7% of respondents
